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## SECTION C DESCRIPTIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

This is a performance based Statement of Work (SOW). The effort performed hereunder will be evaluated in accordance with the performance standards/acceptance quality levels described below and the evaluation methods described in provision CAR H09 in Section H.

TITLE: Machinery Information Systems & Technology - In-Service Engineering (ISE)/Life Cycle Engineering Management (LCEM)

### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Ship Systems Engineering Station (SSES), located in Philadelphia, PA, is a vital part of the Naval Surface Warfare Center, Carderock Division (NSWCCD) and is the Navy's principal Test and Evaluation Station and In-Service Engineering Agent. The Machinery Research and Engineering Department (Code 90) provides systems engineering and technical management of ship systems and equipment including In-Service Engineering (ISE) and Life Cycle Engineering Management (LCEM) for the U.S. Navy Ship Machinery Information Systems & Technology Program at NSWCCD-SSES. These services include: engineering development; test and evaluation; system surveys and assessments; on-site technical support; technology insertion; performance specifications; performance and data analysis; system integration; installation support; Fleet support; Integrated Logistics Support (ILS) document preparation; and training support pertinent to U. S. Navy Machinery Information Systems & Technology systems afloat. Code 9520 is responsible for specific Navy shipboard systems including the following Maintenance Monitoring and Decision Support Systems.

The Total Ship Information Management System (TSIMS) was originated by the COMNAVAIRFORCE community to assist combat systems watch officers to manage casualty control, situational awareness and logistical references to combat systems equipment. TSIMS provides users with a searchable graphical interface that reduces personnel response time significantly. TSIMS is currently distributed on CD-ROMs and updates are performed based on aircraft carrier availability. Additionally, TSIMS is an approved Navy Information/Application Product Suite (NIAPS) program.

The Submarine Maintenance Monitoring Information System (SMMIS) is the suite of software applications used by Submarine Performance Monitoring Teams (PMT) and NAVSEA engineers to record and analyze submarine maintenance data. NSWCCD is the Software Support Activity (SSA) for SMMIS and maintains the software code for the major elements of SMMIS suite. SMMIS includes the front-end software used by Performance Monitoring Teams, the Website used by NAVSEA engineers for reviewing and trending data, the Website used by PMTs to record data, and the Website used by PMTs and NSWCCD to track test gear.

The Operational Sequencing Systems (OSS) provide US Navy shipboard engineering personnel with technically correct, logically sequenced written procedures, charts and diagrams tailored to each ship's specific configuration. OSS dictates the procedures to be followed to complete major plant status changes. The use of OSS ensures proper system and equipment operation and minimizes damage to equipment and injury to personnel.

1.2 This SOW establishes the level of effort required for the furnishing of Government-off-the-Shelf (GOTS) software, and Integrated Logistics Support Services for HM&E technical data development, maintenance and management. It is estimated that 80% of the effort will be off-site and 20% will be on-site. This task order shall provide technical data packages, technical data conversion, distribution of technical data, management of technical data, miscellaneous technical data systems support, and the design development, testing and fielding support of GOTS software.

## 3.0 TASK REQUIREMENTS

The contractor shall provide engineering services in support of In-Service Engineering (ISE) and Life Cycle Engineering Management (LCEM) for the U.S. Navy Ship Machinery Information Systems & Technology Branch. Specific tasking includes the following:

3.1 Update and maintain the TSIMS data sets for aircraft carriers.

3.1.1 Sketch and mark-up the space and system drawings to reflect new installations and associated configuration changes as a result of equipment installations. The sketches shall then be drafted in CAD format. Document changes shall be verified against the configuration in each applicable space.

3.1.2 Test the software and data updates and record results prior to delivery to ship. Provide a Test Plan and Test Report.

3.1.3 Load, test, and demonstrate the updated TSIMS product, and a report shall be provided for any demonstration, test, or installation.

3.1.4 Provide training on all TSIMS processes and systems developed, incorporated, and/or integrated. Such training shall include all necessary guides, manuals, and training courses required to effectively transfer knowledge to necessary Government personnel. The contractor shall provide support for all training onboard each installation ship and a Training Report.

3.2 Update and maintain the Submarine Maintenance Monitoring Information System (SMMIS).

3.3 Develop and update Operational Sequencing Systems (OSS)

3.3.1 Develop/generate Engineering Operational Sequencing Systems (EOSS), including Aviation Fuel OSS (AFOSS), Sewage Disposal OSS (SDOSS), Catapult OSS (CATOSS), Catapult Lube Oil OSS (CLOSS), Cargo Fuel OSS (CFOSS), and other OSS for HM&E systems on U.S. Navy steam, diesel, and gas turbine powered ships, including the creation of EOSS files in SGML and CGM formats and conversion to PDF; use of ISODRAW and AdeptEditor software to incorporate necessary changes to update existing and generate new construction EOSS packages; and update of the Content@ database for selected HM&E ship systems.

3.3.2 Update Engineering Operational Sequencing Systems (EOSS) Aviation Fuel OSS (AFOSS), Sewage Disposal OSS (SDOSS), Catapult OSS (CATOSS), Catapult Lube Oil OSS (CLOSS), Cargo Fuel OSS (CFOSS), and other OSS for HM&E systems to reflect the following:

3.3.2.1 Authorized ship alterations installed during depot maintenance periods or equivalent. During the maintenance periods, shipboard configurations shall be modified. Ship checks shall be conducted in order to validate changes to EOSS procedures due to these modified alterations.

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3.3.2.2 Approved Procedure Changes (APCs) issued by letter by NSWCCD-SSES.

3.3.2.3 Changes in response to OSS feedbacks and NAVSEA (Naval Sea Systems Command) advisories; and

3.3.2.4 Brief ship's force personnel of changes upon ship check completion.

3.4 Prepare test plans, test reports, and perform data collection, statistical analyses, and interpretation for prototype systems and components. Perform equipment testing, test site and/or field/shipboard evaluations, and equipment/component validation. Provide test materials, and design, fabricate, and assemble applicable components/test fixtures/articles for testing and evaluation. Perform timekeeping duties in the Standard Labor Data Collection and Distribution Application (SLDCADA) and track man-hours/time in the Corporate Database (CDB) system.

3.5 Assist with development of long range plans, schedules and alteration packages, and attend technical and programmatic meetings as required. Participate in meetings and provide technical/design input, and revision recommendations for Government review, and maintain/record meeting minutes. Prepare and recommend updates to technical manuals; installation drawings and procedures; and other technical documentation for systems, equipment and components.

3.6 Provide ISE and LCEM support for other related machinery information systems & technology.

### 3.7 Software Development Requirements

3.7.1 The contractor shall define a general Software Development Plan (SDP) appropriate for the computer software effort to be performed under this task order. The SDP shall, at a minimum:

3.7.1.1 Define the contractor's proposed life cycle model and the processes used as a part of that model. In this context, the term "life cycle model" is as defined in IEEE/EIA Std. 12207.0;

3.7.1.2 Contain the information defined by IEEE/EIA Std. 12207.1, section 5.2.1 (generic content) and the Plans and Procedures in Table 1 of IEEE/EIA Std. 12207.1. In all cases, the level of detail shall be sufficient to define all software development processes, activities, and tasks to be conducted;

3.7.1.3 Identify the specific standards, methods, tools, actions, strategies, and responsibilities associated with development and qualification;

3.7.1.4 Document all processes applicable to the system to be acquired, including the Primary, Supporting, and Organizational life cycle processes as defined by IEEE/EIA Std. 12207 as appropriate. Such processes shall be equivalent to those articulated by CMMI<sup>®</sup>;

3.7.1.5 Include the content defined by all information items listed in Table 1 of IEEE/EIA Std. 12207.1, as appropriate for the system and be consistent with the processes proposed by the developers;

3.7.1.6 Adhere to the characteristics defined in section 4.2.3 of IEEE/EIA Std. 12207, as appropriate;

3.7.1.7 Describe the overall life cycle and include primary, supporting, and organizational processes based on the work content of this task order;

3.7.1.8 Adhere to the framework defined in IEEE/EIA Std. 12207.0, including, but not limited to, defining the processes, the activities to be performed as a part of the processes, the tasks which

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support the activities, and the techniques and tools to be used to perform the tasks;

3.7.1.9 Include a level of information sufficient to allow the use of the SDP as the full guidance for the developers. In accordance with section 6.5.3a of IEEE/EIA Std. 12207.1, such information shall at a minimum contain, specific standards, methods, tools, actions, reuse strategy, and responsibility associated with the development and qualification of all requirements, including safety and security.

#### 4.0 DELIVERABLES

All products, documentation, data files and masters for products/reports etc. developed in support of this task order are the property of the Government and shall be turned over to the Government upon request or completion of this task order.

4.1 Copies of all deliverables shall be prepared in the contractor's electronic format and shall be distributed to the designated Task Order Manager (TOM).

4.1.1 Monthly Status Report – Progress reports, due by the 10th working day of each month, shall contain a breakdown of funding details to date and projections, a summary of efforts performed, and deliverables provided for the reporting period.

4.1.2 Meeting Minutes – Meeting minutes, due 10 working days following the meeting.

4.1.3 Test Plans – Test Plans, due within 15 days of initial testing kick off meeting and no later than 15 days prior to the start of testing.

4.1.4 Technical Reports – for any meetings, site visits, conferences, tests, training, etc. that pertain to this task order, due within 10 working days after the completion of each test, project, or site visit, etc. and shall provide detail of the work performed and all significant findings.

4.1.5 Plan of Action and Milestone (POA&M) – due within 15 days of Government request, for any major project associated with this task order.

4.1.6 Technical documents and/or technical document revisions, drawings and/or drawing revisions – due no later than 30-days after the proposed drawing change or action is provided by the Government.

4.1.7 Final Report – due upon completion of the task order.

4.2 Copies of the following OSS-specific deliverables shall be prepared in the contractor's electronic format and shall be distributed to the TOM.

4.2.1 Verification/Cold Check Agenda – due 2 weeks prior to check.

4.2.2 Procedures and Diagrams Annotated During Verification/Cold Check – due upon completion of check.

4.2.3 Report on Status of Ship Systems, briefing Ships support upon Check completion – due 5 days after completion of ship check.

4.2.4 Development Schedule (new development packages only) – due 10 days prior to cold check.

4.2.5 Configuration Check Data Sheet (w/o Component Procedure (CP) Nos., but with noun acronyms) – due 10 days after cold check.

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4.2.6 Pre-Hot Check Review Package (new development packages only) – due 10 days prior to hot check.

4.2.7 Hot Check Package (new development packages only) – due 5 days prior to hot check.

4.2.8 Report on Changes to Baseline (new development packages only) – due 10 days after hot check.

4.2.9 Final Package for Review – due at conclusion of ship check.

4.2.10 Final NSWCCD Approved Printmasters Disks and/or Electronic Copy (SGM and CGM Format) – due 1 day after receipt of review comments.

4.2.11 NSWCCD Final Approved Package – due 1 day after receipt of review comments.

4.2.12 Completed Configuration Check Data Sheet (with CP Nos.) – due 10 days after hot check.

4.2.13 Report on Status of Final Review Package – due 10 days after ship check.

4.2.14 EOSS Status Report – due weekly.

4.3 Software Development Plan (SDP) – due 30 days post award. The SDP shall be delivered to the Government for concurrence and shall not vary significantly from the initial plan proposed to the Government for evaluation. The contractor shall obtain Government concurrence with the SDP for all computer software to be developed or maintained under this effort. Any changes, modifications, additions or substitutions to the SDP shall also require approval by the Government prior to their implementation.

## 5.0 INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

Final inspection and acceptance of all work performed, reports, and other deliverables shall be performed at the place of delivery by the TOM.

5.1 General Acceptance Criteria – General quality measures, as set forth below, shall be applied to each deliverable received from the contractor under this task order.

5.1.1 Accuracy – Work Products shall be accurate in presentation, technical content, and adherence to accepted elements of style.

5.1.2 Clarity – Work Products shall be clear and concise. Any/All diagrams/text shall be easy to understand and be relevant to the supporting narrative.

5.1.3 Consistency to Requirements – All work products must satisfy the requirements of this task order.

5.1.4 File Editing – All text and diagrammatic files shall be editable by the Government.

5.1.5 Format – Work Products shall be submitted in hard copy and in media (SGML, CGM or PDF) mutually agreed upon prior to submission. Hard copy formats shall follow any specified Directives or Manuals.



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5.1.6 Timeliness – Work Products shall be submitted on or before the due date specified in this task order or submitted in accordance with a later scheduled date determined by the Government.

5.2 Acceptance – The TOM shall review, for completeness, preliminary or draft documentation that the Contractor submits, and may return it to the Contractor for correction. Absence of any comments by the TOM shall not relieve the Contractor of the responsibility for complying with the requirements of this work statement. Final approval and acceptance of documentation required herein shall be by letter of approval and acceptance by the TOM. The Contractor shall not construe any letter of acknowledgment of receipt material as a waiver of review, or as an acknowledgment that the material is in conformance with this work statement. Any approval given during preparation of the documentation, or approval for shipment shall not guarantee the final acceptance of the completed documentation.

## 6.0 GOVERNMENT FURNISHED ACCESS/INFORMATION/MATERIALS

6.1 The Government will provide the contractor with user IDs, passwords, and necessary access for completion of this task order which will be coordinated through the TOM.

6.2 Government Furnished Information (GFI) – The Government will provide the contractor with all information and Government proprietary data to complete the specific task within 2 weeks of specific tasking.

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## SECTION H SPECIAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

Clause No. HQ-C-2-0037 "Organizational Conflict of Interest" of the basic contract is hereby invoked under this solicitation and the resultant task order. NOTIFICATION CONCERNING DETERMINATION OF SMALL BUSINESS SIZE STATUS

For the purposes of FAR clauses 52.219-6, NOTICE OF TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE, 52.219-3, NOTICE OF TOTAL HUBZONE SET-ASIDE, 52.219-18, NOTIFICATION OF COMPETITION LIMITED TO ELIGIBLE 8(A) CONCERNS, and 52.219-27 NOTICE OF TOTAL SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE, the determination of whether a small business concern is independently owned and operated, not dominant in the field of operation in which it is bidding on Government contracts, and qualified as a small business under the size standards in this solicitation, and further, meets the definition of a HUBZone small business concern, a small business concern certified by the SBA for participation in the SBAs 8(a) program, or a service disabled veteran-owned small business concern, as applicable, shall be based on the status of said concern at the time of award of the SeaPort-e MACs and as further determined in accordance with Special Contract Requirement H-19.

### 52.219-6 NOTICE OF TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE (JUNE 2003)

(a) Definition. "Small business concern" as used in this clause, means a concern, including its affiliates, that is independently owned and operated, not dominant in the field of operation in which it is bidding on Government contracts, and qualified as a small business under the size standards in this solicitation.

(b) General. (1) Offers are solicited only from small business concerns. Offers received from concerns that are not small business concerns shall be considered nonresponsive and will be rejected. (2) Any award resulting from this solicitation will be made to a small business concern.

(c) Agreement. A small business concern submitting an offer in its own name shall furnish, in performing the contract,

only end items manufactured or produced by small business concerns in the United States or its outlying areas. If this procurement is processed under simplified acquisition procedures and the total amount of this contract does not

exceed \$25,000, a small business concern may furnish the product of any domestic firm. This paragraph does not apply to construction or service contracts.

### Option to Extend the Term of the Task Order

(a) The Government may extend the term of this task order under option CLINs/SUBCLINs by written notice to the Contractor anytime within the period of performance of the task order; provided, that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to exercise the option(s) at least thirty days before the task order expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

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(b) The total duration of this task order, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed four (4) years.

CAR-H09 Performance-Based Acquisition Evaluation Procedures for a SeaPort e Task Order (MAR 2006)  
(NSWCCD)

(a) Introduction: The contractor's performance on this task order will be evaluated by the Government, in accordance with this task order clause. The first evaluation will cover the period ending twelve months after the date of task order award with successive evaluations being performed for each twelve-month period thereafter until the contractor completes performance under the task order. Based on the evaluation results, the PCO will assign an overall performance rating in accordance with paragraph (b) of this clause. The purpose of the evaluation is to determine remedies that may be invoked due to "Unsatisfactory" performance. If the PCO assigns an "Unsatisfactory" performance rating for the period evaluated, the PCO may take unilateral action, in accordance with clause 52.246-5 entitled "Inspection of Services-Cost Reimbursement", dated Apr 1984, in Section E of the base contract, to provide for a fee reduction covering the performance period evaluated. This clause provides the basis for evaluation of the contractor's performance and for determining if the fee amount should be reduced due to "Unsatisfactory" performance.

(b) Performance Ratings: The Government will evaluate the contractor's performance of the Statement of Work under the task order for each twelve month period of performance, using the measurable performance standards set forth in the Performance Requirements Summary Table in the SOW, or elsewhere in the task order, and the PCO will assign one of the following ratings:

- (1) Excellent
- (2) Very Good
- (3) Satisfactory
- (4) Unsatisfactory

The standards associated with these ratings are given in the following Table 1.

(c) Evaluation Objective: The purpose of the evaluation and the inclusion of a remedy to the Government for unsatisfactory contractor performance under this task order is to ensure that the Government receives at least "Satisfactory" overall performance.

(d) Performance Evaluation Criteria: The contractor's performance will be evaluated on an annual basis using the criteria and standards provided for each task objective in the Performance Requirements Summary Table, and considering the criterion in Tables 2 through 4 of this task order clause.

(e) Organization: The performance evaluation organization consists of the Procuring Contracting Officer (PCO), who will serve as the Evaluation Official, and the Task Order Manager (ToM).

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(1) ToM: The ToM will provide ongoing performance monitoring, evaluate task performance based on the task order Performance Requirements Summary, prepare the evaluation report, including a recommended overall performance rating, and submit the report to the PCO for final decision within thirty days after the end of the evaluation period. The ToM will maintain the written records of the contractor's performance so that a fair and accurate evaluation is made.

(2) Procuring Contracting Officer (PCO): The PCO is responsible for properly administering the performance evaluation process, maintaining the official performance evaluation file, and making the decision about the overall performance rating and whether to reduce the fee if performance is rated as unsatisfactory.

(f) Evaluation Schedule: Each performance evaluation will cover the previous twelve months of performance. The Government will evaluate all work under the task order performed by the contractor during the twelve-month period. Following each evaluation period, the PCO (or Contract Specialist if so designated by the PCO) and the ToM will hold a meeting with the contractor's Senior Technical Representative to review performance under the task order during the previous twelve months, including overall trends, specific problem areas, if any, and their resolution. Other Government and contractor personnel may also participate as deemed appropriate.

(g) Contractor's Self-Evaluation: The contractor may also submit a Self-Evaluation Report for consideration. The report must include an overall performance rating for the task order, covering the evaluation period, and may include whatever information the contractor deems relevant to support that rating. The report shall not exceed two (2) pages in length.

(h) Performance Evaluation: The PCO will make the decision on the overall performance rating for the work performed under the task order within thirty days after receipt of the evaluation report from the ToM. The decision will be based upon the ToM's recommendations, the contractor's comments, including any Self-Evaluation Report, and any other information deemed relevant by the PCO. The PCO shall resolve disagreements between the ToM's recommendations and the contractor's comments/report regarding the evaluation. The PCO will provide a copy of the evaluation report, including the overall rating, to the contractor within five working days after completion of the evaluation.

(i) Contractor's Review of the Evaluation Report: Contractors shall be given a minimum of 15 calendar days to submit comments, rebut statements, or provide additional information. The PCO shall consider the contractor's submission and respond as appropriate. Although the PCO will consider the contractor's comments, rebuttals, or additional information, the PCO may, or may not, change the overall rating. The decision to change the rating based on contractor input at this stage is solely at the discretion of the PCO.

(j) This performance evaluation does not replace any other requirement for evaluating contractor performance that may be required by the base contract, such as a Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) report, or a Task Order Performance Evaluation (TOPE).

(a) Performance of the work hereunder may be subject to written technical instructions signed by the Task Order Manager. As used herein, technical instructions are defined to include the following:

(1) Directions to the Contractor that suggest pursuit of certain lines of inquiry, shift work emphasis, fill in details or otherwise serve to accomplish the statement of work.

(2) Guidelines to the Contractor that assist in the interpretation of drawings, specifications or technical portions of work description.

(b) Technical instructions must be within the general scope of work stated in the task order. Technical instructions may not be used to :

(1) assign additional work under the task order;

(2) direct a change as defined in the "Changes" clause of the base contract;

the level of effort, or the time required for task order performance; or

(4) change any of the terms, conditions or specifications of the task order.

(c) If, in the opinion of the Contractor, any technical instruction calls for effort outside the scope of the task order

or is inconsistent with this requirement, the Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer in writing within ten (10) working days after the receipt of any such instruction. The Contractor shall not proceed with the work affected by the technical instruction unless and until the Contracting Officer notifies the Contractor that the technical instruction is within the scope of this task order.

(d) Nothing in the paragraph (c) of this clause shall be construed to excuse the Contractor from performing that portion of the task order statement of work which is not affected by the disputed technical instruction.

(End of Clause)

52.222-2 PAYMENT FOR OVERTIME PREMIUMS (JUL 1990)

(a) The use of overtime is authorized under this contract if the overtime premium cost does not exceed \$0.00 or the overtime premium is paid for work --

(4) Provide reasons why the required work cannot be performed by using multishift operations or by employing additional personnel.

Thereafter, reports shall be submitted no later than the 10th day after the end of each calendar quarter. For information on when the Contractor shall submit its final report, see [http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/recovery\\_faqs\\_contractors](http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/recovery_faqs_contractors).

(d) The Contractor shall report the following information, using the online reporting tool available at [www.FederalReporting.gov](http://www.FederalReporting.gov).

(1) The Government contract and order number, as applicable.

(2) The amount of Recovery Act funds invoiced by the contractor for the reporting period. A cumulative amount from all the reports submitted for this action will be maintained by the government's on-line reporting tool.

(3) A list of all significant services performed or supplies delivered, including construction, for which the contractor invoiced in this calendar quarter.

(4) Program or project title, if any.

(5) A description of the overall purpose and expected outcomes or results of the contract, including significant deliverables and, if appropriate, associated units of measure.

(6) An assessment of the contractor's progress towards the completion of the overall purpose and expected outcomes or results of the contract (*i.e.*, not started, less than 50 percent completed, completed 50 percent or more, or fully completed). This covers the contract (or portion thereof) funded by the Recovery Act.

(7) A narrative description of the employment impact of work funded by the Recovery Act. This narrative should be cumulative for each calendar quarter and address the impact on the Contractor's and first-tier subcontractors' workforce for all first-tier subcontracts valued at \$25,000 or more. At a minimum, the Contractor shall provide—

(i) A brief description of the types of jobs created and jobs retained in the United States and outlying areas (see definition in FAR 2.101). This description may rely on job titles, broader labor categories, or the Contractor's existing practice for describing jobs as long as the terms used are widely understood and describe the general nature of the work; and

(ii) An estimate of the number of jobs created and jobs retained by the prime Contractor and all first-tier subcontracts valued at \$25,000 or more, in the United States and outlying areas. A job cannot be reported as both created and retained. See an example of how to calculate the number of jobs at [http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/recovery\\_faqs\\_contractors](http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/recovery_faqs_contractors).

(8) Names and total compensation of each of the five most highly compensated officers of the Contractor for the calendar year in which the contract is awarded if—

(i) In the Contractor's preceding fiscal year, the Contractor received—

(A) 80 percent or more of its annual gross revenues from Federal contracts (and subcontracts), loans, grants (and subgrants) and cooperative agreements; and

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(B) \$25,000,000 or more in annual gross revenues from Federal contracts (and subcontracts), loans, grants (and subgrants) and cooperative agreements; and

(ii) The public does not have access to information about the compensation of the senior executives through periodic reports filed under section 13(a) or 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ([15 U.S.C. 78m\(a\), 78o\(d\)](#)) or section 6104 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

(9) For subcontracts valued at less than \$25,000 or any subcontracts awarded to an individual, or subcontracts awarded to a subcontractor that in the previous tax year had gross income under \$300,000, the Contractor shall only report the aggregate number of such first tier subcontracts awarded in the quarter and their aggregate total dollar amount.

(10) For any first-tier subcontract funded in whole or in part under the Recovery Act, that is valued at \$25,000 or more and not subject to reporting under paragraph 9, the Contractor shall require the subcontractor to provide the information described in paragraphs (d)(10)(i), (ix), (x), (xi), and (xii) of this section to the Contractor for the purposes of the quarterly report. The Contractor shall advise the subcontractor that the information will be made available to the public as required by section 1512 of the Recovery Act. The Contractor shall provide detailed information on these first-tier subcontracts as follows:

(i) Unique identifier (DUNS Number) for the subcontractor receiving the award and for the subcontractor's parent company, if the subcontractor has a parent company.

(ii) Name of the subcontractor.

(iii) Amount of the subcontract award.

(iv) Date of the subcontract award.

(v) The applicable North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code.

(vi) Funding agency.

(vii) A description of the products or services (including construction) being provided under the subcontract, including the overall purpose and expected outcomes or results of the subcontract.

(viii) Subcontract number (the contract number assigned by the prime contractor).

(ix) Subcontractor's physical address including street address, city, state, and country. Also include the nine-digit zip code and congressional district if applicable.

(x) Subcontract primary performance location including street address, city, state, and country. Also include the nine-digit zip code and congressional district if applicable.

(xi) Names and total compensation of each of the subcontractor's five most highly compensated officers, for the calendar year in which the subcontract is awarded if—

(A) In the subcontractor's preceding fiscal year, the subcontractor received—

(1) 80 percent or more of its annual gross revenues in Federal contracts (and subcontracts), loans, grants (and subgrants), and cooperative agreements; and

(2) \$25,000,000 or more in annual gross revenues from Federal contracts (and subcontracts), loans, grants (and subgrants), and cooperative agreements; and

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(B) The public does not have access to information about the compensation of the senior executives through periodic reports filed under section 13(a) or 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ([15 U.S.C. 78m\(a\), 78o\(d\)](#)) or section 6104 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

(xii) A narrative description of the employment impact of work funded by the Recovery Act. This narrative should be cumulative for each calendar quarter and address the impact on the subcontractor's workforce. At a minimum, the subcontractor shall provide—

(A) A brief description of the types of jobs created and jobs retained in the United States and outlying areas (see definition in FAR [2.101](#)). This description may rely on job titles, broader labor categories, or the subcontractor's existing practice for describing jobs as long as the terms used are widely understood and describe the general nature of the work; and

(B) An estimate of the number of jobs created and jobs retained by the subcontractor in the United States and outlying areas. A job cannot be reported as both created and retained. See an example of how to calculate the number of jobs at [http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/recovery\\_faqs\\_contractors](http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/recovery_faqs_contractors).

Audit and Records- Negotiation

MARCH 2009

(a) As used in this clause, "records" includes books, documents, accounting procedures and practices, and other data, regardless of type and regardless of whether such items are in written form, in the form of computer data, or in any other form.

(b) *Examination of costs.* If this is a cost-reimbursement, incentive, time-and-materials, labor-hour, or price redeterminable contract, or any combination of these, the Contractor shall maintain and the Contracting Officer, or an authorized representative of the Contracting Officer, shall have the right to examine and audit all records and other evidence sufficient to reflect properly all costs claimed to have been incurred or anticipated to be incurred directly or indirectly in performance of this contract. This right of examination shall include inspection at all reasonable times of the Contractor's plants, or parts of them, engaged in performing the contract.

(c) *Cost or pricing data.* If the Contractor has been required to submit cost or pricing data in connection with any pricing action relating to this contract, the Contracting Officer, or an authorized representative of the Contracting Officer, in order to evaluate the accuracy, completeness, and currency of the cost or pricing data, shall have the right to examine and audit all of the Contractor's records, including computations and projections, related to—

(1) The proposal for the contract, subcontract, or modification;

(2) The discussions conducted on the proposal(s), including those related to negotiating;

(3) Pricing of the contract, subcontract, or modification; or

(4) Performance of the contract, subcontract or modification.

(d) Comptroller General.—

(1) The Comptroller General of the United States, or an authorized representative, shall have access to and the right to examine any of the Contractor's directly pertinent records involving transactions related

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to this contract or a subcontract hereunder and to interview any current employee regarding such transactions.

(2) This paragraph may not be construed to require the Contractor or subcontractor to create or maintain any record that the Contractor or subcontractor does not maintain in the ordinary course of business or pursuant to a provision of law.

(e) *Reports.* If the Contractor is required to furnish cost, funding, or performance reports, the Contracting Officer or an authorized representative of the Contracting Officer shall have the right to examine and audit the supporting records and materials, for the purpose of evaluating—

(1) The effectiveness of the Contractor's policies and procedures to produce data compatible with the objectives of these reports; and

(2) The data reported.

(f) *Availability.* The Contractor shall make available at its office at all reasonable times the records, materials, and other evidence described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), and (e) of this clause, for examination, audit, or reproduction, until 3 years after final payment under this contract or for any shorter period specified in [Subpart 4.7](#), Contractor Records Retention, of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), or for any longer period required by statute or by other clauses of this contract. In addition—

(1) If this contract is completely or partially terminated, the Contractor shall make available the records relating to the work terminated until 3 years after any resulting final termination settlement; and

(2) The Contractor shall make available records relating to appeals under the Disputes clause or to litigation or the settlement of claims arising under or relating to this contract until such appeals, litigation, or claims are finally resolved.

(g) The Contractor shall insert a clause containing all the terms of this clause, including this paragraph (g), in all subcontracts under this contract that exceed the simplified acquisition threshold, and—

(1) That are cost-reimbursement, incentive, time-and-materials, labor-hour, or price-redeterminable type or any combination of these;

(2) For which cost or pricing data are required; or

(3) That require the subcontractor to furnish reports as discussed in paragraph (e) of this clause.

The clause may be altered only as necessary to identify properly the contracting parties and the Contracting Officer under the Government prime contract.

Subcontracts for Commercial Items

MARCH 2009

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this clause—

“Commercial item” has the meaning contained in Federal Acquisition Regulation [2.101](#), Definitions.

“Subcontract” includes a transfer of commercial items between divisions, subsidiaries, or affiliates of the Contractor or subcontractor at any tier.



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(b) To the maximum extent practicable, the Contractor shall incorporate, and require its subcontractors at all tiers to incorporate, commercial items or nondevelopmental items as components of items to be supplied under this contract.

(c)(1) The Contractor shall insert the following clauses in subcontracts for commercial items:

(i) [52.203-13](#), Contractor Code of Business Ethics and Conduct (Dec 2008) (Pub. L. 110-252, Title VI, Chapter 1 ([41 U.S.C. 251 note](#))).

(ii) [52.203-15](#), Whistleblower Protections Under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Section 1553 of Pub. L. 111-5). Applies to subcontracts funded under the Act.

(iii) [52.219-8](#), Utilization of Small Business Concerns (May 2004) ([15 U.S.C. 637\(d\)\(2\)](#) and (3)), in all subcontracts that offer further subcontracting opportunities. If the subcontract (except subcontracts to small business concerns) exceeds \$550,000 (\$1,000,000 for construction of any public facility), the subcontractor must include [52.219-8](#) in lower tier subcontracts that offer subcontracting opportunities.

(iv) [52.222-26](#), Equal Opportunity (Mar 2007) (E.O. 11246).

(v) [52.222-35](#), Equal Opportunity for Special Disabled Veterans, Veterans of the Vietnam Era, and Other Eligible Veterans (Sept 2006) ([38 U.S.C. 4212\(a\)](#));

(vi) [52.222-36](#), Affirmative Action for Workers with Disabilities (June 1998) ([29 U.S.C. 793](#)).

(vii) [52.222-39](#), Notification of Employee Rights Concerning Payment of Union Dues or Fees (Dec 2004) (E.O. 13201). Flow down as required in accordance with paragraph (g) of FAR clause [52.222-39](#).

(viii) [52.222-50](#), Combating Trafficking in Persons (Feb 2009) ([22 U.S.C. 7104\(g\)](#)).

(ix) [52.247-64](#), Preference for Privately Owned U.S.-Flag Commercial Vessels (Feb 2006) ([46 U.S.C. App. 1241](#) and [10 U.S.C. 2631](#)) (flow down required in accordance with paragraph (d) of FAR clause [52.247-64](#)).

(2) While not required, the Contractor may flow down to subcontracts for commercial items a minimal number of additional clauses necessary to satisfy its contractual obligations.

(d) The Contractor shall include the terms of this clause, including this paragraph (d), in subcontracts awarded under this contract.
